Description

VL45 Radio pendant light by [Vilhelm Lauritzen](#) for [Louis Poulsen](#).

Architect Vilhelm Lauritzen originally designed the VL45 light for the Danish broadcasting company's headquarters building in Copenhagen, known as the Radiohuset (now home to the Royal Danish Academy of Music).

This simple, functional and elegant design was originally manufactured by Louis Poulsen, becoming its most popular design when it was first released eight decades ago. It has now been reissued to Lauritzen's original design specification.

The VL45 pendant shade has three layers of mouth-blown opal glass. The inner and outer layers are made of transparent polished glass, while the intermediate layer is white glass.

The shade is designed to cast a uniform and gently diffused light. Downwards directed light is produced from the opening at the base of the shade.

Pendant tube and shade fitting are brushed brass.

Supplied with 4m cable and white ceiling rose.

Available in two sizes: 25cm and 37cm diameter.
