Description

Akari 20N lamp by [Isamu Noguchi](#) for [Vitra](#).

In 1951, American/Japanese artist and designer Isamu Noguchi started to design the Akari Light Sculptures, a total of over 100 hand-made Shoji-paper models for table lights, standard lamps or ceiling luminaires. For the name of this lighting series he chose the word "akari", the Japanese terms for brightness and light, and also lightness.

The Akari 20N lamp is made with handmade washi paper and bamboo ribbing, supported by a metal frame. The lamps are handcrafted in the family-run Ozeki workshop based in Gifu, Japan.
