Tatu lamp by [André Ricard](#) for [Santa & Cole](#).

Santa & Cole have released a new edition of André Ricard's classic Tatu lamp. The pop-art icon, Tatu, was conceived in three sections that rotate independently, allowing the lamp to adapt to its environment, from desk to shelf to wall. Ricard was inspired by the light found overhead in a plane and how it could illuminate his book, but not disturb his companion sat beside him.

Santa & Cole have further enhanced the design with the introduction of LED technology, with adaptable light intensity (0-100 %) and including an adjustable converging lens that changes the width of the beam from narrow (30°) to wide (50°).

Made of ABS plastic, use as a table or wall light. Fittings included.

Available in red or Santa & Cole white.
