524 Tabouret Berger stool by [Charlotte Perriand](#) for [Cassina](#).

Designed by Charlotte Perriand and shown for the first time in Tokyo at the Synthèse des arts exhibition in 1955, the 524 Tabouret Berger is a stylised version of milking stools used by Berger shepherds.

Works well with the higher [Meribel stool](#). Can also be used as a small table.

Featuring three turned legs, the stool comes in three solid wood finishes: natural oak, black-stained oak, natural American walnut.
