Eames ESU bookcase by [Charles & Ray Eames](#) for [Vitra](#).

In 1949, Charles and Ray Eames developed a new system of free-standing multifunctional shelves which - similar to the Eames House that dates from the same time - were constructed strictly in keeping with the principles of industrial mass production: the Eames Storage Units (ESU).

Shelves in maple plywood with birch face veneer, clear lacquer. Sliding doors in moulded plywood. Panels lacquered in various colours.

Metal surfaces in black powder coating.

Panels available in: 83 pale blue, 86 rusty orange, 84 Eames red, 85 fawn.
