Eames DSR side chair by [Charles & Ray Eames](#) for [Vitra](#).

Eames Plastic Side Chair is a contemporary version of the legendary Fiberglass Chair. It was produced in collaboration with Zenith Plastics for the Museum of Modern Art in New York's Low-Cost Furniture Design Competition and was the first industrially manufactured plastic chair.

Polypropylene seat shell available with no seat upholstery, with an upholstered seat pad, or with fully upholstered seat and back.

The Hopsak cover in 13 colours can be combined with the eight colours of the seat shell. Together with the base frames, this creates any number of individual possible combinations. On fully upholstered chairs, the upholstery is fixed to the shell with black or white piping.

White and basic dark DSR chairs without seat upholstery are available on a 1-2 week delivery time.

DSR = Dining Height Side Chair Rod Base.

Please note new height for 2015 - raising seat by 2cm.

Basic dark glides for hard and soft floors. Also available in white - please enquire for details.
