To celebrate the centenary of Robin Day's birth, twentytwentyone has collaborated with a select group of designers to compose an editorial of one of his most enduring furniture designs.

Of his choice of textile, Martino Gamper comments: "A British wool, a British weaver, a great British designer's chair - and a little bit of Italian thrown into the mix."

Martino Gamper has chosen to cover the Reclining chair in White Noise, a fabric hand-woven in London by self-taught Weaver Daniel Harris of the London Cloth Company. The London Cloth Company was established in 2011 as the first micro-mill to open in London. It specialises in quality woven cloths produced using traditional techniques and a restored shuttle loom from the 1870s.

The Reclining chair was originally designed in 1952 and was considered by Robin Day to be one of his most successful and iconic designs. The high comfort levels and clearly articulated structure fulfilled Day's exacting design sensibilities. The modernist vocabulary of the Reclining chair encapsulates principles that were inherent in much of his wide body of work.
