Designed in 1933, the Safari foot stool is one of the world's first 'build-it-yourself' furniture. It is designed with functionality in mind and can easily be put together and taken apart without tools.

The obvious companion to the Safari stool is the matching Safari chair, which Kaare Klint designed with the same 'knock-down' principle in mind.

The frame is made from solid wood, available in ash (oiled) or smoked ash (oiled). Seat in canvas or leather. Straps in natural saddle leather.
