Description

Random pendant light by [Bertjan Pot](#) for [Moooi](#).

Moooi was founded in 2001 by Marcel Wanders and Casper Vissers and is named after their native Dutch word for beautiful - the third 'o' in the brand name stands for an extra value in terms of beauty and uniqueness.

Like all his new products, the Random light was born from Bertjan Pot's love for material experiment: Here, a yarn of resin is coiled randomly around an inflatable beach ball. When the yarn has solidified into a translucent fabric the ball is deflated and removed through the round top opening.

The Random light is as much a sculpture as it is a suspension light. It brings softness and some magic to any interior.

Light projects through from a centrally suspended bulb.
