Avian consists of an armchair and two sizes of sofa. The use of formed plywood to define structure and offer support continues the typography first conceived in the celebrated designs for the Royal Festival Hall in 1951. The structure of design is clearly revealed with fixings exposed and the upholstered unit raised on stainless steel sled leg. The design for Avian incorporates the option of an upholstered liner for the inside face of armrests. The Avian family reflects Robin Days perceptive ability to create understated and functional furniture.

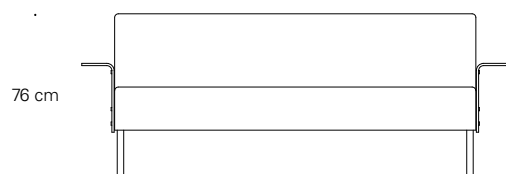

Softwood frame with foam and elasticated webbing. Fixed upholstery in a range of fabrics and leather.

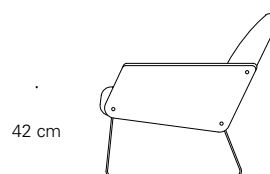
Oak veneered formed plywood armrest. Optional upholstered plywood liner for inside face of armrest.
