

TAKING CARE OF AND MAINTAINING YOUR FURNITURE

Most of our storage units are lacquered and veneered, but we sometimes use complementary materials to make the special design absolutely perfect. If we don't describe here the material used in your piece, please visit our website or contact us or your local retailer for more information.

HAND-MADE SURFACES SHOULD NEVER BE EXPOSED TO STRONG DIRECT SUNLIGHT

Differences in colour may occur.

LACQUERED SURFACES

We use a high-quality acid-based lacquer that is best cleaned with a damp cloth and a little soapy water. Should you accidentally chip the lacquer, you can order a small can of touch-up paint from us (please note that the lacquer may become slightly yellow after exposure to daylight. This means that new lacquer will be a slightly different colour.

However, this will not be noticeable unless a large area is involved, in which case we recommend you to go to a local paint shop and have the repair carried out professionally.)

VENEERED SURFACES

For all of our wooden storage units, we use a high-quality cut veneer, treated with an environmentally-friendly oil wax. Since both the cabinet and the treatment are natural products, you should reapply the wax when the surface becomes dry. We recommend OSMO oil wax maintenance spray. NATURAL STONE

We use stones such as limestone and Carrara marble (which is also a limestone) in some of our table tops and storage units. In the stone cutting factory, a "nano" treatment is applied to close the pores of the stone and make the surface more durable.

Natural young limestones are natural and luxurious materials that can react with common fluids, such as alcohol, soda and sometimes even mineral waters.

You can help to maintain the surface and treatment by cleaning it only with natural soap and water; chemicals will remove the surface treatment.
